The event is organized by the Computer Education Research Association of Chinese Universities and hosted by Óbuda University, with technical support from IEEE Hungary Section.

Selected high-quality accepted papers will be recommended for publication in high-impact international journals. The submitted manuscripts should be written in English and contain sufficient details including key concepts and novel features of the work, and must be formatted according to the Template. All submitted manuscripts intended for publication in the conference proceedings (Springer/IEEE Xplore) must comply with academic integrity requirements. The similarity index with previously published work should normally not exceed 25%. Manuscripts with excessive overlap will be rejected.
